- In Study 1 compared South Korean and American participants, demonstrating that only Koreans, not American, categorized individuals based on relational cues. Korean committed more memory errors when distinguishing characters sharing the same relationship.
- Study 2 aims to compare categorization patterns between Korean and Japanese participants. Currently involved in translating scenarios from Korean to Japanese.
